The Clubhouse

The heart of our Club, our clubhouse is a charming two-story, lodge-style structure that features a balcony with scenic views, a ballroom with a large fireplace, a full-service kitchen, men's and women's locker rooms and a recreation room.

The clubhouse has undergone a full renovation, updating our facility to be better suited to fit the needs of our membership, including a private Pub as well as an adjacent deck to provide further socializing options.

Members and guests have the opportunity to rent the ballroom or game room for private functions based on availability.



The Swimming Pool

The pool area becomes the social center for water-loving families and overheated tennis players during the summer.

The 25-meter pool and separate zero entry baby pool are surrounded by grassy lawns, flowers, comfortable lounges and chairs, and shady umbrellas.

Not interested in a dip? That's ok! Hit up the Snack Shack for a drink or enjoy lunch or dinner served poolside while the kids play on the newly constructed children's play set.

Friday night happy hours are a draw with themed parties while summer holidays are celebrated family style with events around the pool.



Tennis

We're called the Racquet Club for a good reason! Widely considered "The Best Clay Courts" in Pittsburgh, our staff works tirelessly to ensure our 8 Har-Tru courts are always in top shape.

Adjacent to the court sits our full-service pro shop featuring comprehensive stringing services as well as top merchandise. Our Director of Racquet Sports, Keith Salmon, tennis support staff provide programs throughout the summer to engage our members.

- Cardio Tennis - Cardio tennis is the best way to get a great workout while working on your game.

Platform Tennis

Racquet sports happen year-round at the Fox Chapel Racquet Club!

Host to many national events, the platform facilities continue to be praised as one of the best on the circuit. Our facilities include 5 lighted and heated courts as well as a covered fire pit, paddle lodge including a kitchenette, bathrooms, lounge area and bar.

Platform, by the nature of the game, is a social sport. In addition to everyday availability to find players to get onto the court with, we regularly have organized events focusing on the social and fun aspects of the game rather than competition. Male or Female Platform players of all abilities interested in competitive play can join one of our many teams competing in the western PA Platform Tennis Association Leagues.



Pickleball

The fastest growing racquet sport, Pickleball is perfect for players of all ages due to its versatility and ease of play. It combines elements of tennis, badminton, and ping pong into a fun, social game.

The Fox Chapel Racquet Club currently offers one Pickleball court, though construction has begun to provide three additional courts and will be ready for play this summer.



Kids Activities

Junior Tennis

Summer tennis is available for kids of all ages and coached by our wonderful team of Pros. From our Little Grippers class for our youngest enthusiasts (4-5) all the way through our Collegiate players who must be Pro approved, the courts are filled with excitement throughout the season.

Piranhas Swim Team

All swimmers, beginners to age 17, and their families, are invited to join the fun of competitive swimming. If your swimmer can “swim” a length of the pool and wants to be part of a team, we encourage him or her to join. It is a great way to strengthen skills and become a better swimmer.

Private swim lessons designed for all skill levels are available as well.

Platform Tennis

The number one reason kids want to play a sport is to have fun. Our emphasis is on playing and fun while keeping kids active and involved through a variety of games and activities!



Membership

Membership to the Club is by invitation only. To become a member of the Club, you must receive an invitation and be sponsored by an existing member.

Following an invitation, the sponsoring member will facilitate all necessary steps to help you become a member at the Fox Chapel Racquet Club. If you do not already have a sponsoring member, alternative arrangements can be made for you to enter the membership process.

The standard application process can take up to six weeks, so please keep this in mind if you have a specific date that you wish to begin your membership.



How to become a member

1. Candidate must have a Sponsoring Member who completes a Proposal for Membership Application, Letter of Recommendation, Secondary and 3 letters of recommendation.
1. Candidate must attend a Club function and meet with at least 3 Board Members and attend an Admissions Meeting.
1. Candidate's names are circulated to entire membership for feedback.
1. Admissions Committee votes to accept or deny application.
1. Admissions Committee proposes that the Board of Governors vote on Candidates acceptance for membership.

New Members have the option to join under Summer Associate Membership Classification. This option is designed to allow new members to pay a discounted initiation fee of \$3,900 plus the Standard Monthly Dues, for a membership valid from May through September, in the initial year only. On October 1, Summer Associate members must decide to either resign their membership or continue to Full Membership Status by paying the balance of the Active Membership Initiation Fee.

- Initiation Fees can be paid in full or a monthly payment plan.
- Discounted rates are available for children of members, and individuals under 35 years old
